- 1. THIS SHOW IS SANCTIONED BY THE AMERICAN DAIRY GOAT ASSOCIATION AND ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL.
 - The senior doe and junior doe shows are separately sanctioned for both days and there are two separately sanctioned buck shows on Saturday evening.
- 2. Show Order:
 - Saturday
 - o Senior Does- Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, Recorded Grade
 - o Showmanshir
 - o Junior Does- Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, AOP, Recorded Grade
 - o Buck Ring 1- Nigerian Dwarf, AOP
 - o Buck Ring 2- AOP, Nigerian Dwarf
 - Sunday
 - o Senior Does- Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, Recorded Grade
 - Junior Does- Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, AOP, Recorded Grade
 - THE ORDER OF THE SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE. The show committee reserves
 the right to change the show order as needed to keep the show running in a smooth and
 orderly fashion.
- 3. Current health papers within 30 days of the show are required FOR OUT OF STATE ANIMALS ONLY. All animals exhibiting visible signs of infectious diseases will not be permitted to be unloaded or shown. Animals arriving will be examined by a veterinarian or show committee member. Questionable animals will not be unloaded. The decision of the show veterinarian will be final. Exhibitors must present their health check-in card before checking entries at the secretary's table. All bucks over six months of age must be tied in their pens
- 4. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. An original registration certificate or a valid duplicate application stamped by ADGA is required on all animals less than 6 months of age. No copies, telephone calls, or emails will be accepted in lieu of original certificate. All registration papers must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show. Base date is the date of the show.
- 5. Does entered in Saturday's or Sunday's shows must be checked in and in place by 8:30am the day of the show. Check in times will be Friday evening 6pm-10pm, Saturday and Sunday 7am-8:30am. Bucks must be checked in and in place by 2:00pm Saturday.
- 6. There is no charge for showmanship classes. Showman's age is determined as of January 1, 2025. Youth should wear white. Bucks may not be used. Wethers may be used for showmanship only.
- 7. There will be no pre-show milk out, but over uddering is not recommended.
- 8. All milk must be disposed of in designated area on the fairgrounds
- Western Reserve Dairy Goat Association and the Ashtabula County Agricultural Society shall not be held liable for any loss or injury to persons or property while on the Ashtabula County Fairgrounds.
- 10. Non sportsmanship like conduct will not be tolerated. Such conduct may result in disbarment from WRDGA shows.
- 11. Paid entry indicates acceptance of all show rules and regulations. The Show Committee reserves the right to interpret any show rile not adequately covered by these or the ADGA rules.
